

RING SIZE GUIDE

1. PRINT THIS PDF AT FULL SIZE

Do not allow your printer to adjust to fit the page with the 'scale to fit page' or 'shrink to fit page' options.

2. CHECK PRINT SIZE

The line below should measure 10cm.



PLEASE NOTE: This PDF is a guide only and is most effective when printed. Ring measurements are very precise, carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.

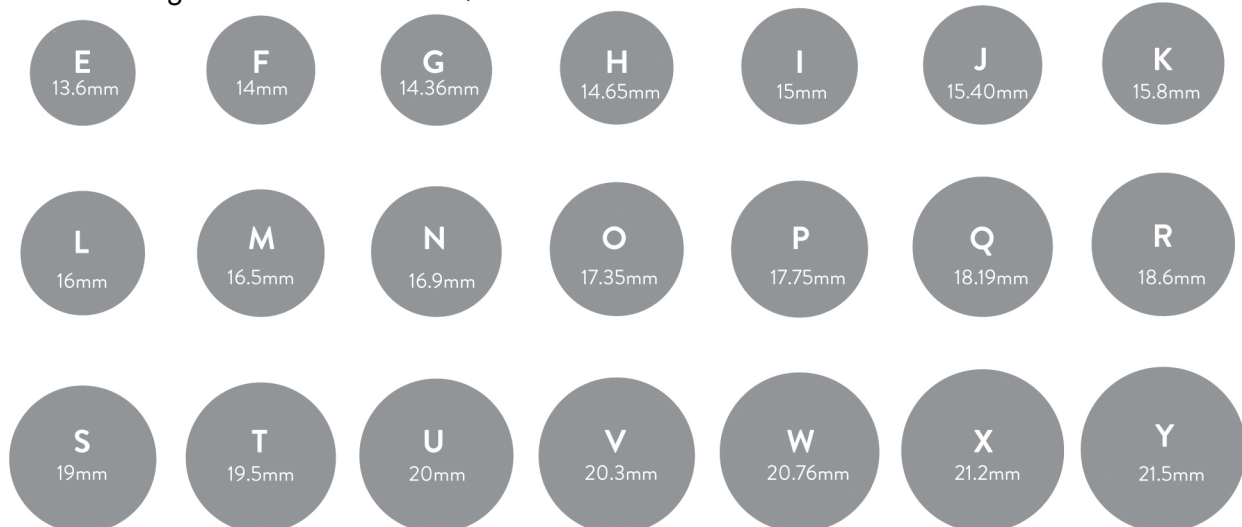
TO MEASURE YOUR FINGER:



1. Cut out the ring sizer above and make a slit where indicated.
2. Make a loose circle by slipping the end through the slit, then place on the finger being measured and tighten.
3. To get a more accurate result, please make sure hands are warm as cold fingers are thinner.
4. Some people's finger joints are larger than the base of the finger where the ring will sit, so measure your finger joint with the ring sizer also, to double check ring will go over finger joint.

TO MEASURE AN EXISTING RING:

1. Use a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles.
3. To match your ring size, find the circle which completely fills the INSIDE of the ring, without any overlap. Your ring size is the letter shown within the circle (the diameter of the inside of the ring is written below the letter).
4. For the most accurate result, move your ring over the circles beginning with the smaller sizes, and use a ring that has a similar width of band as the one you'd like to purchase.
5. If the ring falls between two sizes, we can make half sizes too.
